

FY2019 Survey on assistance to Technical Intern Trainees after Returning to Home Countries (Summary)

1. Survey Purpose

This survey aims to study the employment status of the technical intern trainees who returned to their home countries in FY 2018 (hereinafter referred to as “ex-trainees”), job/skill transfer support and acquisitions of skills, etc. during the technical intern training for supervising organizations and implementing organizations of individual enterprise-type training (hereinafter referred to as “supervising organizations etc.”).

2. Target

Supervising organizations etc.

3. Method

- (1) Send survey forms and online response manuals to survey targets.
- (2) Survey targets answer the questionnaire and return it to OTIT survey office or respond online.
- (3) Multiple choice and free description


4. Number of respondents and response rate

Cooperative relationship between supervising organizations, etc. and sending organizations of trainees after returning to home countries


Cooperation status with sending organizations

In relation to the survey on situations of ex-trainees after returning to home countries, the number of sending organizations keeping a cooperative relationship with supervising organizations was 5,347, which is 81.2% of the sending organizations.



In a cooperative relationship with sending organizations


Regarding the number of sending organizations which the supervising organizations keep a cooperative relationship with, the largest number of supervising organizations answered “2 or 3”, accounting for 30.9%.



Employment status of ex-trainees after returning to home countries


Employment status of ex-trainees after returning to home countries

In regards to the employment status after returning to their home countries, 61.4% of the total respondents answered either “employed and working” (51.9%), “scheduled to work” (4.5%), or “started own business” (5.0%).



Specific job duties after returning to home countries


67.5% of the ex-trainees responded that their specific job duties are “same as training” (42.8%) or “same type of duties as the training” (24.7%).



Assistance to ex-trainees after returning to their home countries


Assistance status for promoting skill transfer to ex-trainees

74.3% of the supervising organizations etc. answered that they provided assistance for promoting skill transfer to ex-trainees (including assistance in cooperation with sending organizations)



Specific details of assistance

As for the specific details, “Issuance of Certificate of Completion of Technical Intern Training, Certificate of Employment, etc. ” was the most common at 71.3%, “Information and recommendation of employment after returning to home countries” was 41.0%, and “Consultations regarding employment and entrepreneurship after returning to home countries” followed by 39.4%.
